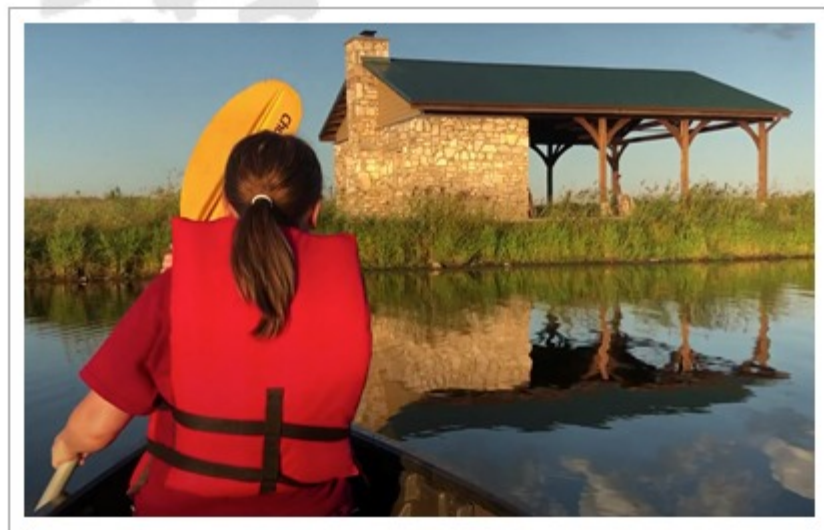

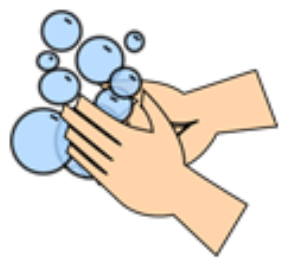
Camp 2021 Reminders

- Campers are not allowed access to **PHONES, EXCEPT** in case of emergency and with permission from the camp session director.

Camp Hygiene



Camp and personal **CLEANLINESS** are especially important in light of the potential for Covid-19 transmission.

- Parents must be mindful to **KEEP ILL CHILDREN AT HOME**, as well as any child who is confirmed to have Covid-19 or has been exposed to Covid-19 within two weeks of his/her camp session start date.
- Camper **MASK WEARING** is encouraged by day, not recommended during sleep, and **OPTIONAL AT ALL TIMES**.
- Campers are encouraged to **WASH** hands regularly, with soap and water:
 - after blowing the nose
 - upon leaving the restroom
 - between activities
 - before and after meals and snacks

Pack It UP!



What every wise camper needs:

- Bedding or sleeping bag, individual
- Bath towels and washcloths
- Bible, notebook, and pen
- Clothes for one week, plus extra changes
- Flashlight
- Insect repellent
- Medicine, if required
(See the Health Form for details.)
- Personal-care items
(deodorant, shampoo, toothbrush...)
- Shoes, two pair
(one with closed toes for hiking, mud)
- Swimsuit
- Sunscreen
- Personal Water Bottle

Leave Behind

The health, safety, and well being of each camper is paramount to us. Since camp life is varied--including challenging outdoor and learning activities--it's important campers' clothing and gear are safe and sturdy. In keeping with camp values, campers should NOT bring the following:

- ⊗ Alcohol, illegal drugs, tobacco products
- ⊗ Bikinis
- ⊗ Clothing shorter than two inches above the knee
- ⊗ Crop, halter, or tank tops (shirt covers shoulders and stomach)
- ⊗ Electronic devices (including hand-held games and cell phones)
- ⊗ Fireworks
- ⊗ Weapons (firearms, knives ...)

Early Bird Discounts

- For Trailblazer II: **\$10 off** if registration and fee are postmarked by 05.15.2021.
- For Elementary: **\$25 off** if registration and fee are postmarked by 05.15.2021.
- For Senior and Junior Teen: **\$25 off** if registration and fee are postmarked by 06.15.2021.

Family Discount: Pay full price for one camper, then receive **\$15 off** the fee for each additional sibling you send. This discount applies to Elementary, Junior Teen and/or Senior Teen campers only.
